Selecting Woodland Ways trustees

Trustees are normally selected from existing members. Periodically, all members are invited to offer their services as a trustee. Prospective trustees may attend trustees' meetings before deciding whether or not to stand for election.

Trustees are elected at AGMs in accordance with the constitution, and are asked to sign a declaration of eligibility on election. All trustees have signed Charity Commissions' standard declaration of eligibility, referenced CSD 1382.

Officers (chair, secretary, treasurer, vice chair) are selected from amongst the trustees. Other roles such as membership secretary, newsletter editor, work party leader do not need to be trustees although it is expected that these roles will be filled by existing members.
