What's been happening this summer?

As you might expect, Woodland Ways has been affected by coronavirus although we have been doing our best to manage our community woods whilst keeping safe.

Work party news

We resumed work parties after a three month break, in July 2020 where we were divided into two groups so that each group was no more than six people, and the two groups did not come into contact with each other. We successfully raked the hay from Woodland Ways Pond and from the Pond Covert orchard in our separate groups, but did not have the AGM we normally precede this work party with.

In August 2020 the work party for the first time in fifteen years we didn't rake the hay in Natterer's Wood - a work party of six would not have been able to do the job. however, we did cut out the small bushes which self-seeded into it so that they did not obstruct the mower. We also started clearing stiff weeds from the bat ditch itself, to maintain its definition. By September, the rules for meeting had relaxed for community events where we could have up to thirty people, so our September work party was for unlimited people and fifteen of us continued to clear stiff weeds from the bat ditch. We also cleared some overgrowing branches from one of the paths in Natterer's Wood.

In October we are back at Natterer's Wood, and will only be able to work in groups of six again.

We are trying to keep in touch with regular work party attendees, because as the rules change we are arranging work parties on a month-by-month basis. If you would like to attend a work party, do get in touch for the latest information. As always, we are also very pleased for you to be a member even if you don't come to work parties, because your support really does help keep us going.
